Fortifications recall a military past, while breweries and flax mills bear witness to ancestral know-how. Through picturesque villages and paths, Flanders invites you on a journey where tradition and modernity meet in harmony.



Bergues, the fortified city: A walk through time

Entering Bergues means passing through one of its **five historic gates**, veritable sentinels that still bear the names of neighboring villages. Once inside, the streets, alleyways and houses whisper tales of heroic battles and brilliantly executed strategies.

The impressive ramparts, designed by Vauban, Louis XIV's famous military engineer, offer breathtaking views over the surrounding countryside. A stroll along these fortifications, still largely intact, will plunge you into the sumptuous times of the **Counts of Flanders** or **Spanish rule**.

But Bergues isn't just a journey into the past. It's also a lively, welcoming town, where you can savor the moment, between the gentle landscapes and the warmth of its inhabitants.



Between Flanders and History: A stroll through Hondchoote and Watten

On the edge of French Flanders, cradled by the north winds and the murmur of centuries, lies **Hondchoote**, a town of discreet but irresistible charm. Here, the bricks whisper and the heritage offers itself without diversions to those who know how to look.

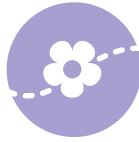

La Plaine au Bois: Silence and Memories

You walk slowly through **La Plaine au Bois**, in Esquelbecq. At first sight, it's a peaceful, almost timeless place. The trees sway gently in the breeze, the grass dances in the subdued light. But a heavy silence pervades. You feel the weight, the invisible but very real presence of a past that refuses to fade.

On May 28, 1940, in this land so serene today, chaos and horror were unleashed. A hundred British soldiers, captured after heroic resistance to German troops, were coldly executed here. You walk on this soil steeped in history, and you seem to hear the echo of their voices, the last cry of their struggle.

You stop in front of the stele erected in 2010. It invites you to reflect on fraternity and the sacrifices made to preserve peace. This place of remembrance prompts you to rediscover the value of courage and friendship, while offering a setting where **memory lives on**, carried by the breath of the wind. Perhaps, at this very moment, this place becomes yours: the place where past and future meet.

A land of gourmet delights, combining tradition and conviviality. Here, every dish tells a story, every flavor evokes a savoir-faire handed down from generation to generation. From cozy estaminets to artisanal brasseries and local specialties, culinary discovery becomes a true immersion in the Flemish soul. Whether you're a lover of mature cheeses, dishes simmered with beer or sweet treats, let yourself be guided by the aromas and flavors of this region where the pleasure of the table is an art of living.

A Dive into the Soul of Estaminets

Take a seat. In front of you, a menu where **Flemish specialties** reign supreme. The Bergues cheese tart, golden brown to perfection, tempts you with a glance. Next to it, the Potjevleesch, a meat terrine in jelly, rests in its earthenware case, ready to reveal its subtle flavours. And what about the carbonnade flamande, simmered in a home-made beer, whose spicy-sweet aroma tickles your nostrils?

A waiter, smiling, recommends a local beer. The first sip is an explosion of flavours: delicate bitterness, spicy notes, a taste of the land that imposes itself without artifice. Each ingredient, each recipe tells the story of a tradition, a know-how handed down from generation to generation.

Emblematic Estaminets

Some places go beyond the simple culinary experience. **Le Bruegel** in Bergues, **Le Trou Flamand** in Ledringhem and **La Taverne du Westhoek** in Quaëdypre are much more than restaurants: they are guardians of Flemish culture.

Here, people still play frogs, toast under hop garlands, and are surprised by an accordion player who comes to liven up the evening. Time slows down, conversations drag on, and you understand why, in Flanders, indulgence is an art of living.





A land to enjoy throughout the seasons

Each season brings its own culinary treasures. In winter, you can warm up with a Welsh, a comforting dish with melted cheddar, while in summer, you can enjoy a platter of local cheeses accompanied by a cold beer on the terrace.

Bergues cheese, the undisputed star of the region, is best enjoyed with a piece of farmhouse bread and an amber beer to bring out its aromas. But the discoveries don't stop there: **Palet de Killem, Petit Bissezele, organic goat's cheese...** Each bite is an immersion in ancestral know-how, where each product bears the imprint of the Flemish soil.

And then there's **the Bergues sausage**, inherited from the Spanish era, whose spices awaken your taste buds. You're already thinking of extending the experience by visiting a local farm to discover the secrets behind the production of these exceptional products.

Sweet teeth are not left out : **Strynen**, waffles flavoured with vanilla and sugar, bring back childhood memories. Savour them slowly, with your eyes closed, and let their sweet taste warm your soul.



Discover the craft breweries

Flemish beer is not just a drink : it's a living heritage, a passion that can be shared. In Esquelbecq, **the Thiriez brewery** opens its doors to you for a journey to the heart of brewing. We'll tell you the story behind each batch, from the precise steps involved in brewing to the perfect effervescence of a well tapped beer.

In Bergues, **the Westhoek Brewery** welcomes you to an unusual place: a former abattoir transformed into a brewery. The atmosphere is unique, the aroma of hops fills the air, and each sip immerses you a little more in the richness of this brewing region. Enjoy a platter of cheeses and charcuterie, gazing into the warm atmosphere, savouring the moment to the full.

A windmill without wings: The magic of the 'Rosmeulen'

Ah, windmills and wind... An inseparable duo? Not so sure! Here, when the wind plays tricks on you, the Flemish find a solution. And not just any solution: **the Rosmeulen**, a windmill... on horseback in Volckerinckhove!

Yes, you read that right. Instead of waiting for an uncertain breeze, a horse circled the building and powered the millstones to grind the grain. A perfect blend of ingenuity and pragmatism, proving once again that the Flemish have no shortage of resources! So who else can boast such an invention?



Vines in the North? That's right!

Wine and Flanders, two words that are rarely associated... and yet ! In Hondschoote, at the **foot of the Moulin de la Victoire**, vines have taken root. Their fruit gives rise to Fleur de Lin, a white wine that defies all climatic clichés.

Beer is king here, but wine also has its place! To discover the secrets of this daring wine-growing adventure, head to **the Musée Jean-Pierre Pinceel, Musée des Vendanges**. The Flemish fear nothing... not even the climate!



The lyre tree: Plant art in Esquelbecq

When nature and music meet, the result is... **a tree in the shape of a lyre!**

In Esquelbecq, in front of the music school, stands a tree like no other. Its sculpted foliage seems to vibrate in the wind, like an ode to the harmony between man and his environment. Simple coincidence or deliberate nod? You be the judge!



A café... with giant organs!

Just imagine: you push open the door of a café, order a drink and suddenly... a **mechanical organ** starts playing. A magical, almost timeless atmosphere.

Land of museums

Here, the past is not something to be contemplated, it's something to be experienced. At every street corner, in every museum, at the sound of a melody, history comes alive and takes us on a timeless journey. From Watten to Herzelee, between centuries-old traditions and unusual glimpses, each place you visit reveals a unique facet of this vibrant heritage. Arches reaching for the sky, canvases bathed in light, machines of yesteryear and intoxicating music... Each discovery is an invitation to listen to the stories of the past and let yourself be carried away by the soul of Flanders. Get ready for a journey where emotion and curiosity will be your best guides.

La Maison des Archers: A Meeting with Tradition

Your journey begins in **Watten**. At the entrance to a small museum, a **giant** awaits you. His name? **Dédé l'Archer**. He looks at you, as if to gauge your curiosity before letting you into the fascinating world of archery.

Here, you can't contemplate the past behind dusty shop windows. It challenges you. From medieval bows to tricoloured 'birds' suspended in the air, each object tells the story of the exploits of Flemish archers. Standing in front of, a 30-metre-high pole, the thought crosses your mind: what if you were in their shoes, bow in hand, staring at the target?

Le Mont de Piété: Art that Crosses the Centuries

A few kilometres further on, the streets of **Bergues** lead you to a jewel of Flemish architecture: Le Mont de Piété. The building seems to breathe history. Its stones have seen merchants, artists and dreamers come and go. As you cross the threshold, a respectful silence settles in.

In front of you, ancient canvases capture glimpses, scenes of life, emotions frozen in time. Then, suddenly, you come across **The Old Man with a Dog by Georges de La Tour**. The lighting in the work is striking. You have the impression of being there, in that dark room, next to the old man, his instrument and his faithful dog. Each painting takes you on a visual journey, where light and shadow play a hypnotic dance.





The Jeanne Devos Museum: Snapshots from the past

In Wormhout, another door opens onto a more intimate past. **The Jeanne Devos Museum** doesn't just show you history: it makes you feel it. In this former residence, old objects and black-and-white photographs capture faces, gestures and fragments of life from another time.

You stop in front of a photograph. A family on a festive day. A woman's gaze seems to cross the years to reach you. Who was she? What was she thinking? You immerse yourself in these images as if in a novel, each page a frozen memory. The smell of old wood, the creak of the wooden floor beneath your feet... You are somewhere else, in a world where time stands still.



The Ecomuseum: The Beat of the Rural Past

Then it's on to **Ledringhem**. Here, the past can't be told, it can be touched and heard. As you enter the **Les Racines de la Vie Rurale** ecomuseum, a familiar smell greets you: that of grain, aged metal and weathered wood.

You pass old farm machinery. They've been carefully restored, yet still bear the marks of the hands that used them. You can imagine the sound of hooves on beaten earth, the song of harvesters in golden fields, the crackle of the fire in a Flemish farmhouse on a winter's evening. Here, every object has a soul, every tool tells of a labour, a life.

Welcome to **Esquelbecq**, to a place like no other, where imagination comes to life and humour reigns supreme. As soon as you walk through the doors of **the Musée des Gigottos**, you enter a zany and surprising world.
