

« The Adventures of Nicolas... with Piste and Trésor-Summer 2026 »

Article 1: Organizer

The Hauts de Flandre Community of Communes (CCHF), on behalf of its intermunicipal tourism office “Terre de Flandre Tourisme,” with its registered office located at 468, rue de la Couronne de Bierne, 59380 BERGUES, in metropolitan France, is organizing a contest with no purchase necessary titled “The Secrets of Terre de Flandre with Clues and Treasure” (hereinafter referred to as “the Contest”), in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in these rules.

This contest will take place in 2026 **from Monday, August 3, at 9:00 a.m. to Monday, September 21, at 9:00 a.m.**

This promotion, which highlights the villages of Terre de Flandre, is neither organized nor sponsored by Facebook, Google, Apple, or Microsoft.

Article 2 : Conditions of participation

2.1 This contest is open to any individual who is of legal age (at least 18 years old) and has a smartphone and internet access, with the exception of employees of the organizing company and their families, as well as anyone who participated in the development of the contest. Under no circumstances may a participant enter on behalf of another person.

The organizer assumes no liability for any misuse or incident related to the use of the app, the smartphone, internet access, geolocation, or the maintenance or malfunction of servers, telephone lines, or any other technical connection.

2.2 The mere act of participating in this contest implies full and unconditional acceptance of these rules. Failure to comply with these rules will result in the automatic cancellation of participation and any potential award of the prize.

Article 3 : Terms and Conditions for Participation

This contest takes place on the “Piste et Trésor” app during the period specified in Article 1. The rules for participation are as follows:

- 1) Download the “Piste et Trésor” app for free; it is available on iOS and Android.
- 2) Complete—in any order you choose—the following trails: “The Adventures of Nicolas: Among the Ch’tis in Bergues,” “The Adventures of Nicolas: The Secret of the Land of Flax in Hondschoote,” “The Adventures of Nicolas in Volckerinckhove: Discovering Flemish Architecture,” and “The Adventures of Nicolas: The Legend of Esquelbecq ”
- 3) Write down the sentence fragments added in the “Secret of the Territory” stage
- 4) Reconstruct the sentence and submit it via the online entry form by clicking this link: [Competition entry form “The Adventures of Nicolas” with Piste and Tresor – Remplir le formulaire](#) **by Monday, September 21, before 9:00 a.m. No entries will be accepted after this deadline.**

Only one entry per person is allowed (same last name, same first name, same mailing and email addresses).

Article 4 : Allocations

A random drawing will be held from among the correct answers received on Tuesday, September 22, at 11:00 a.m.

The prize for this contest is as follows:

The winner will be notified by email or phone. If there is no response within 3 days (by 11:00 a.m. on Friday, September 25), the prize may be awarded to another participant.

The prize is final and non-negotiable; no cash equivalent or other form of compensation will be provided under any circumstances. Under no circumstances may the prize be returned, exchanged, or replaced for any reason, including in the event of loss or theft.

The municipality assumes no liability in the event that the winner is dissatisfied with the prize.

Article 5 : Limitation of Liability

This gift certificate must be used by November 30, 2026.

Terre de Flandre Tourisme and the CCHF shall not be held liable if the prize is not redeemed by November 30, 2026. In such a case, the participant will be deemed to have forfeited the prize. Under no circumstances will this forfeiture give rise to financial compensation, a postponement, or an exchange.

The CCHF and Terre de Flandre Tourisme shall not be held liable if, due to force majeure or circumstances beyond their control, this contest must be modified, shortened, or canceled. The CCHF and Terre de Flandre Tourisme reserve the right to extend the entry period and to postpone any announced dates. Addenda, or in the event of force majeure, amendments to these rules may be published during the contest (for example: the organizing entity reserves the right to replace the prize won with a prize of equivalent nature and value). They will be considered appendices to the rules.

The CCHF and Terre de Flandre Tourisme guarantee participants that the prize offered is genuine, that the contest will be conducted with complete impartiality, and that strict equality among all participants will be maintained (to the best of their ability).

Article 6 : Publication of the regulations

The rules will be available for review throughout the duration of the contest on the website: terredeflandretourisme.com. The rules are available free of charge to anyone who requests them from the organizer at the tourist information offices in Bergues, Esquelbecq, and Hondschoote.

Article 7 : Personal Information

Personal information, including personally identifiable information, provided by participants may be processed electronically to record their participation in the contest and to facilitate the awarding of prizes, subject to their express consent (hereinafter referred to as “Personal Data”).

The data controller is the organizing local authority, namely the Communauté de Communes des Hauts de Flandre, represented by its President, Mr. Paul-Loup TRONQUOY, with its registered office located at 468 rue de la Couronne de Bierne, 59380 BERGUES.

The recipient of the Personal Data is the organizing authority. The data is provided to it solely for the purposes of organizing the contest and will not be used for any other purposes, unless the participants consent.

The personal data collected will be retained until December 31, 2026.

In accordance with the amended law of January 6, 1978, and the General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”) No. 2016/679 of April 27, 2016, each participant has the right to access, correct, and delete personal data concerning them, and may, for legitimate reasons, object to the processing of this information by writing to the Data Protection Officer at the following address: rgpd@cchf.fr. In the event of no response or a response deemed unsatisfactory, a complaint may be filed with the CNIL. (<http://www.cnil.fr/fr/plaintes>).

The data collected is required to participate in the contest. Consequently, individuals who exercise their right to have their personal data deleted before the end of the contest are deemed to have withdrawn from participation.

The organizing entity undertakes to take the necessary technical and organizational measures to protect the confidentiality and security of personal data and to disclose such data only to staff members who need access to it for the purposes of the contest.

Unless otherwise specified, the organizing entity may also reuse this information or share it with partner organizations, in particular for the purpose of sending commercial information by mail or email, with the express consent of the individual concerned. You may contact the organizing entity at any time to request that it cease such use of your personal data by writing to the address provided above.

Article 8 : Disputes

These rules are subject to French law governing contests and sweepstakes.

To be considered, any disputes regarding the contest must be submitted in writing to Terre de Flandre Tourisme, 468 rue de la Couronne de Bierne, 59380 Bergues, no later than ten days after the contest entry deadline as indicated in these rules. No claims will be accepted after this deadline.

The CCHF and Terre de Flandre Tourisme assume no liability in the event of incorrect receipt or non-receipt of electronic entries, for any reason whatsoever.
